Remember the golden rules for multiplying by 10 or 100.

I have written them out to remind you!

The rules are:

- 1. To multiply by ten, move each digit one place to the left, including from the tenths to the units, if necessary.
- 2. The decimal point does not move.
- 3. To multiply by 100 move each digit two places to the left, including crossing from tenths to tens and hundredths to units, if necessary.
- 4. When writing money make sure you have 2 digits after the decimal point: eg £3.20 not £3.2
