$$\begin{array}{r} \text{£ } 2 \cdot 24 \\ \times \quad 6 \\ \hline \text{£ } 13 \cdot 44 \\ \quad \quad \quad 1 \quad 2 \end{array}$$

Remember to keep the decimal points in a row so they line up under each other.
