

This is a game for 2 players. You need two dice, two sets of different coloured counters or cubes and a calculator to check answers.



Player one (blue) goes first and rolls the 2 dice. Add up the total and place a blue counter on a square showing that number. Then player two (red) does the same and places a red counter on the board.

The aim of the game is to get a run of three counters the same colour in a row, either across, down or diagonally.

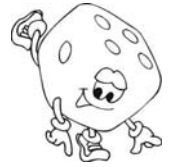
If there is no number on the board available for the total rolled, play goes straight to the next player.



You can make some rules up for yourself. For example: two incorrect additions could lose you the game, or give the other person a free go. You decide!!
