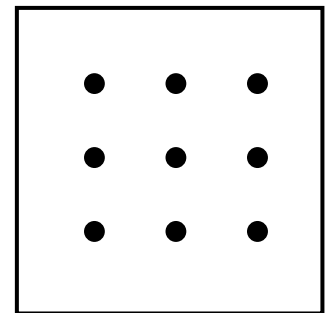
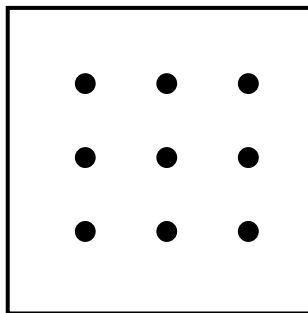
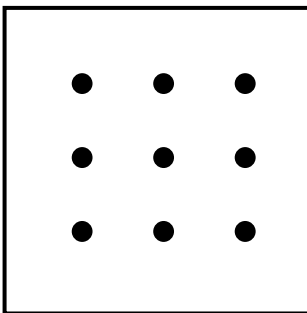
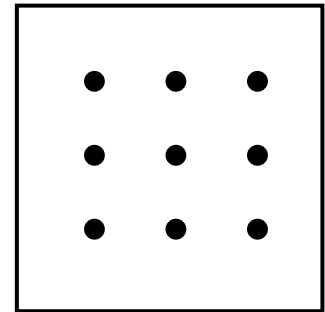
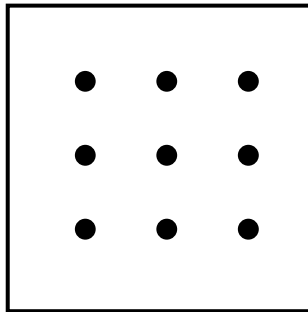
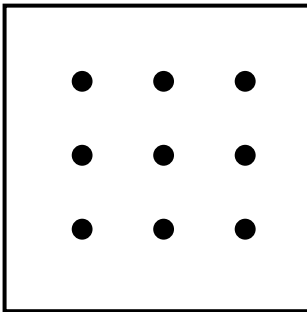
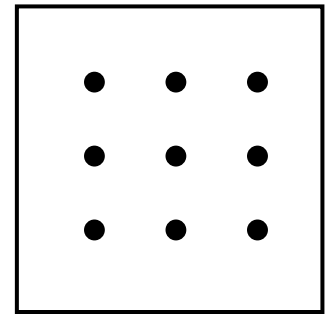
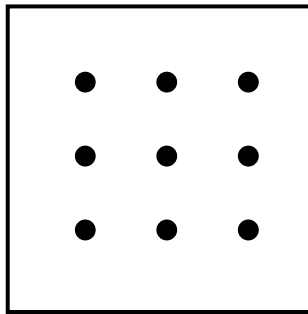
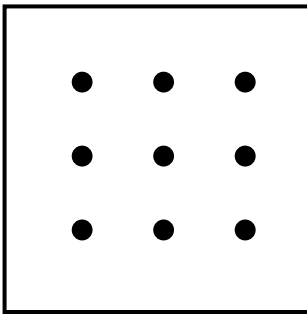
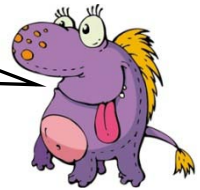


It's best if you have a 9 pin geoboard and some elastic bands to help with this. (They are quite easy to make with nails and a thick board!)

How many different ways can you make 5 sided shapes by joining the dots in straight lines on the drawings of geoboards below ?
