I'm puzzled! What happens to a number of sweets if I divide them by 1?

That's easy! If I have 6 sweets to divide into one pile that means all 6 sweets are in the pile. (All for me!)

6 divided by 1 is 6 .

When you divide a whole number by one, the answer is the whole number. Have a go at these questions:
