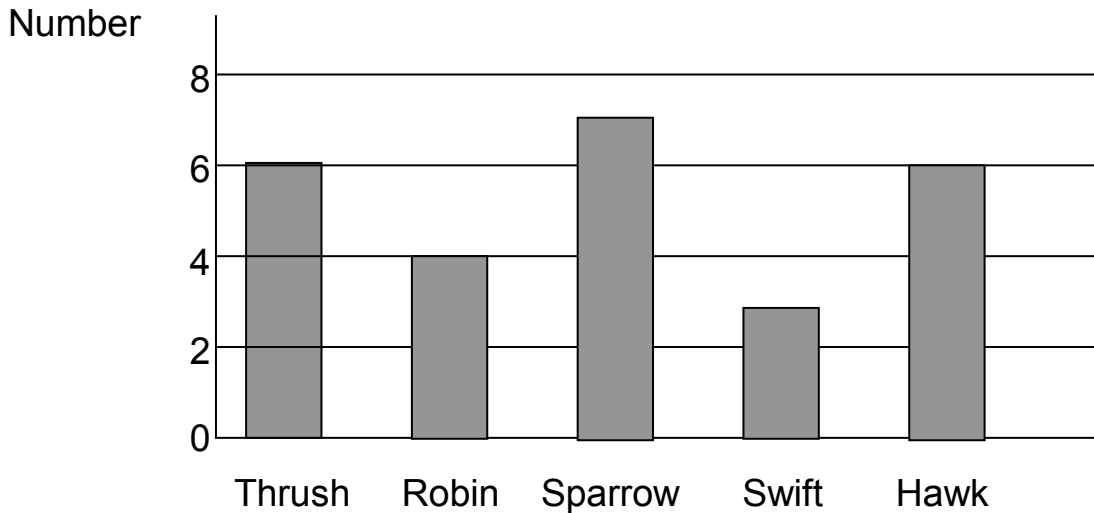


1) Here is a bar chart showing the number of birds that flew into a garden one day.
